They are given physical, mental, social, medical and psychological support. It has been serving such people of the society for the last **14 years**. It has a total population of **180 inmates** and a few dedicated sisters who are serving them. The destitute home is helped by the generous and kind hearted people of the society to meet its day to day basic needs. The land in which it runs is donated by Rt. Rev. Joseph Pathalil, Bishop of Udaipur and President of Catholic diocesan Education Society. The building in which it runs has been donated by the generous and kind hearted donors of the city.

1. This unit is run totally by the donation from the people of good will and assistance from the State government. It is a registered unit under Rajasthan society act 1958. Registration number is 210 Udaipur 99-2000.
2. The constitution of unit is approved by the Registrar under society's act 1958.
3. The Income Tax Commissioner Udaipur vide his letter 496 s/21.6.0 has granted exemption under income tax act 1961 (80G).
4. The Ashadham Ashram Society is also exempted by the income tax department of India to receive unlimited donations by sub-section (iv) of clause (23C) of section 10 vide notification number No. 10/2008-09.
